POSITION SUMMARY:

Provides direction for the program and classroom, and implements program curriculum. Provides a quality experience to children and parents that focuses on the YMCA values: honesty, respect, responsibility, and caring.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- 2. Designs and implements daily lesson/activity plans consistent to YMCA Healthy Eating and Physical Standards, Achievement Gap, and the School-Aged Child Care Curriculum..
- 3. Supervises the children, classroom, and all activities.
- 4. Makes ongoing, systematic observations and evaluations of each child.
- 5. Conducts parent conferences, and maintains positive relationships and effective communication with parents. Engages parents as volunteers.
- 6. Maintains program site and equipment.
- 7. Maintains required program records.
- 8. Attends and participates in all family nights, program activities, and staff meetings.
- 9. Actively seeking to continuously update skills by attending outside workshops and constantly whenever possible, by becoming active in professional organizations and constantly seeking new ideas and materials.
