POSITION SUMMARY:

Under the supervision of the Aquatics Director or designated supervisor, the Aquatics Coordinator will assist in all aspects of the Aquatics programs to include hiring and supervision aquatic staff, and scheduling aquatic programs to the needs and demands of the membership. This position will be responsible for leading and coaching their staff team in the delivery of an outstanding member experience.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Assists in establishing, directing and evaluating aquatic programs.
- Oversee and ensures the delivery of high quality YMCA swim lessons.
- Assists in monitoring daily pool operations to adhere to all state, local and YMCA health and safety regulations.
- Facilitates and/or conducts lifeguarding, swim instruction, first aid and CPR trainings.
- Assists in YMCA fund raising activities and special events.
- Provides exceptional customer service to members and aquatic participants.
- Assist in planning and conducting staff meetings. Attend all staff meetings and trainings as scheduled.
- Act as a leader in emergency situations. Report any accidents or incidents according to Emergency Action Plan. Ensure all members, guests, and program participants are in a safe environment and actively follow branch Emergency Action Plan.
