Stay & Play is available for children ages 6 weeks - 12 years for up to 2 hours each shift at the Brooks Family YMCA.

HOURS: M-F 8am-2pm, 4pm-8pm

Saturday 8am-2pm

Sunday 12:30pm - 4:30pm

Brooks Y Stay & Play Policies:

- Stay & Play is a benefit of a family membership. Parents/guardians are required to stay on site at the Brooks Family YMCA while their children are in Stay & Play.
- Parents/guardians must sign their children in & leave a cell number & area where they will be working out so that Stay & Play attendants can contact them if needed. Staff will assist with checking out all children.
- Parents/guardians are not allowed past the front desk, for the safety of all children, as of 10/7/19. Nursing mothers are an exception, and should check in.
- We have created a **Mother's Nook** in Stay & Play for nursing if needed. For the convenience of all mothers, please refrain from re-arranging furniture.
- Due to the prevalence of food allergies, Stay & Play has a <u>NO FOOD</u> policy.
 Only water (in bottles or sippy cups) and breast milk or formula are allowed.
- All water bottles, diaper bags, etc. must be labeled with the child's name.
- Children with fever, runny nose, lice, cough, diarrhea, vomiting or any other contagious illness within the last 24 hours are not allowed in Stay & Play.
- To prevent the spread of germs, please be sure your child's face and hands are clean before entering Stay & Play. Wipes are available at the check-in desk.
- We understand children may feel uncomfortable at first. However, if a child cries for more than 10 minutes, attendants will contact the parent/guardian & ask them to check their child out of Stay & Play.
- Parents/guardians must supply their own diapers/wipes if there is a possibility a child will need to be changed while they are in Stay & Play.
- Stay & Play attendants will change diapers if necessary using parent/guardian supplied materials, but are not authorized to apply diaper cream.
- Starting Monday 10/7/19, there will be daily planned activities for the children to enjoy. Check the monthly schedule to see what's happening!
