The Cavalier Aquatics Swim Team is a year-round, competitive swim program dedicated to providing all swimmers in the greater Charlottesville/Albemarle area a positive and healthy swimming experience. Cavalier Aquatics offers both YMCA and USA swimming opportunities. The training location is a state of the art 10-lane pool at Brooks Family YMCA located in Charlottesville. This position provides direct leadership, instruction, and motivatino for students in swimming.

This position supports the work of the Y, a leading nonprofit committed to strengthening community through youth development, healthy living and social responsibility.
