POSITION SUMMARY:

This position will be held by a Certified Teacher wanting to provide children with a safe environment while planning/leading daily activities consistent with the policies, procedures and philosophies of the Piedmont Family YMCA. The teacher will express a strong commitment to working with the children and will always be a positive role model, demonstrating initiative, self-direction, and show caring and sensitivity to all children.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Implement daily enrichment activities such as STEM, SEL or Arts & Humanities.
- Develop and communicate clear expectations as guidelines for children.
- Take all necessary and reasonable precautions to protect the children, staff equipment and facility.
- Be aware of the special needs of the children, including allergies, medications, medical history and physical limitations.

- Actively seeking to continuously update skills by attending outside workshops and conferences whenever possible, by becoming active in professional organizations and constantly seeking new ideas and materials.
- Report immediately all accidents, occurrences, safety and maintenance concerns to your supervisor.
- Represent the YMCA by modeling the values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility.
- Promote good communications and relations with all participants and staff.
- Abide by the YMCA's Dress Code.
- Wear name tag while working.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
