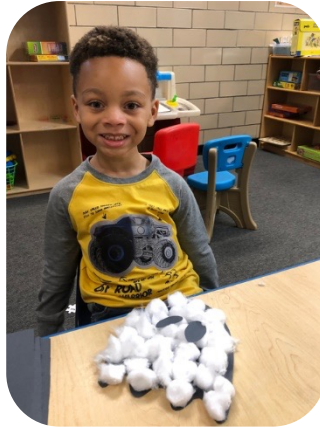

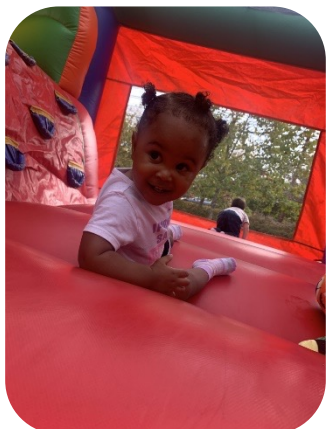
PIEDMONT FAMILY YMCA CHILD CARE CENTER
