

## **EARLY LEARNING CENTER**

(a)Jefferson School

Early childhood education and kindergarten readiness program for economically disadvantaged youth ages 0-5 so that parents can work or study.

### 90% of brain growth happens before kindergarten

- 156 children served
- 135 children, 87%, received scholarships totaling \$573,977
- 95% of children met PALS-PreK kindergarten readiness benchmarks

# **BROOKS FAMILY YMCA** @McIntire Park

In 2017, the YMCA opened the first facility YMCA in Charlottesville for affordable, accessible aquatics, fitness and family recreation.

# **CROZET YMCA** (a) Claudius Crozet Park

From 2011 to 2020, the YMCA leased a satellite facility from Claudius Crozet Park in Western Albemarle for affordable, accessible aquatics, fitness and family recreation.

- 2.546 people served
- 331 people, 13%, received scholarships totaling \$27,206
- 55,529 facility scan-ins

# AFTER SCHOOL @Greene County

Proud partnership with Greene County Schools to provide safe, enriching after school care for youth ages 5-10 so that parents can work or study.

#### 73% of parents need after school to work


- 55 children served



## Membership by jurisdiction




## Our Supporters

In 2019, 144 donors gave \$690,078 to advance the YMCA mission for all!


